





According to Art. 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (general regulation on data protection) hereinafter referred to as "GDPR"), we would like to inform you that:

- 1. The administrator of personal data is University of Białystok. with the seat at Świerkowa Street 20B, 15-328 Bialystok. The Administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted in all matters related to the processing of personal data and the exercise of rights by data subjects under the GDPR, at the email addres: iod@uwb.edu.pl and by post to the address of the Administrator's seat.
- 2. The Administrator processes your personal data (such as name and surname, telephone number, e-mail address, workplace and position, voice and image while using a camera and microphone), will be processed for the purpose of registration, participation and clearance of **International Scientific Conference "Management in Economy 4.0"**, which is organized by Faculty of Management at the University of Białystok.
- 3. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is
 - 1) Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR the permission given to the Administrator (which is given in the online form);
 - 2) Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR indispensability to fulfill legal obligations incumbent on the Administrator in connection with the organisation of the conference to ensure the safety of the participants;
 - 3) Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR the legitimate interest related to the procedures for the realisation and clearance of the Conference, for statistical purposes and the assertion of claims.
- 4. Your personal data may be available for the organisers and participants of the event, the technology providers (MS Teams, YouTube and Facebook) and other entities according to the terms and conditions of these providers services and entities using the conference recordings (the event is recorded) and entities cooperating in the organisation of the conference.
- 5. Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries (except of the need to use MS Teams, YouTube and Facebook) and will not be used for automated decision-making, including profiling.
- 6. Your personal data will be stored by the Administrator until the procedures related to the organisation and clearance of the Conference are completed or until your permission for data processing is withdrawn (iod@uwb.edu.pl), though withdrawal of permission does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of permission before its withdrawal. The technology providers (MS Teams, YouTube and Facebook) and other entities using these technologies store data in accordance with the terms and conditions of these providers services.
- 7. You have the right to:
 - request from the Administrator access to and rectification of personal data,
 - request the erasure or limitation of data processing, on condition that the prerequisites laid down by law are met,
 - object to the processing, on condition that the prerequisites laid down by law are met,
 - request data trasfer, on condition that the prerequisites laid down by law are met,
 - withdraw your permission for processing at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the







processing carried out on the basis of your permission before withdrawal, by sending a statement to: iod@uwb.edu.pl

- lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority: Personal Data Protection Office, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw.
- 8. The provision of your personal data is voluntary, but necessary for registration and participation in the conference (image and voice depending on the form of participation).
- 9. The administrator also informs that the personal data of conference participants may be processed in social media (Facebook, YouTube). This data will only be processed in connection with the broadcast of the conference. The Administrator has no influence on and is not responsible for the content (including messages, comments, photos, personal data) published there by Users, nor for the processing of data by social media.
